

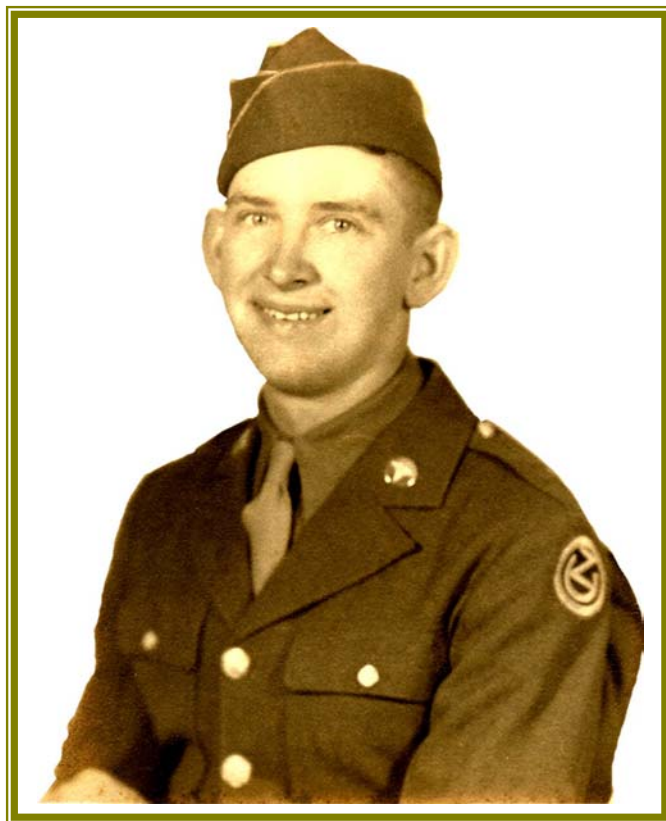

David G. Windmeyer graduated from Grand Pass High School in May 1942. He entered the United States Army in December 1942 from Marshall, Missouri.

David was a Medical Technician 5 with the 727th Amphibious Tractor Battalion. His unit was in many of the South Pacific battles, including New Guinea, Luzon, Leyte, Borneo, Bataan, and Corregidor. David does not talk about his service years, however, he was in some of the major battles that won the war. His group was poised, ready to invade Japan if the atomic bomb had not been dropped. He was discharged in December 1945.

His medals, awards, and citations include:

- Good Conduct Medal
- Bronze Arrowhead
- Philippine Liberation Ribbon
- One Bronze Star

David has been married to his wife, Betty, for sixty-two years. They have

four children and nine grandchildren. He is a farmer and a member of St. Luke's United Church of Christ. David is also a Mason and an American Legion member.
