Ross Gartman joined the United States Army Reserves in 1982 as a medical supply specialist, later transferring to the Missouri National Guard 1140th Engineering Battalion. His active duty deployments include Desert Storm, Operation Iraqi Freedom, and the Winter Olympics in Utah with the 1150th Engineering Battalion.

For his service, Ross was awarded the Army Accommodation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, Southwest Asia Service Medal and Humanitarian Award.

In civilian life, he is founder and president of Heroes Way, a non-profit organization that raises funds for veterans. Heroes Way has begun a project of placing signs along Missouri highways commemorating deceased Missouri veterans. Ross and his wife Denise have three children.
